

Label Setup for Inspected Clients

General Information- We at Parish Meat Processing can print color labels in house (4x4 inch only). We carry a several quality and pricing options listed below. We are also able to print black colored information at packaging time onto labels such as weight, lot number and cut information. This makes it incredibly easy for us to package products quickly and consistently.

By using our enter data at print time system we can save you money. This system requires standard label locations for the weight, lot number, and species/ product name.

For new or smaller clients, we recommend starting with our standard layout 4x4 label with a logo provided by you or a text logo placeholder until you obtain a logo.

For medium to larger clients, we recommend using our semi - standard layout. This gives you more control over the design of your label while still being easily compatible with our in-house packaging time.

- Custom Labels for New Clients without any labels
 - For a fee of \$250.00 we will
 - Use your business name to create a simple placeholder logo while you get a designer to develop your logo.
 - Take your logo and input it into a 4x4 label format with the breed cut of your choice. (Beef, Pork or Lamb)
 - Help you fill out a distribution form for your own label.
 - For a fee of \$50 per recipe we will
 - Modify your label for any recipe that we carry that is designated for clients.
 - Submit your labels for approval with The LA Department of Agriculture.

*We do NOT undertake the design of logos for clients currently, outside of a simple name logo

- Custom Labels for Clients with labels at another facility
 - There is no charge for converting the plant number and address to our facility and adapting the label to work with our Enter Data at Print time system. We require a high-quality label Format to modify the label.
 - The label will be converted to a 4x4 size free of charge if it is decided that we will print labels in-house and use the enter data at print time function.
- Clients with labeling needs outside of what is capable in-house
 - We will work with you on a solution specific to you
 - It will most likely be necessary to have labels printed at a print shop and warehouse them onsite.
 - It will then be the responsibility of the producer to
 - Maintain their label inventory
 - Obtain inspection of labels
 - It may still be possible to use our enter data at print time function
 - If your needs are beyond the capability of our enter data at print time function then we will manually enter pertinent information onto the label.
 - This will be an additional \$0.05 cents per lb hanging weight.

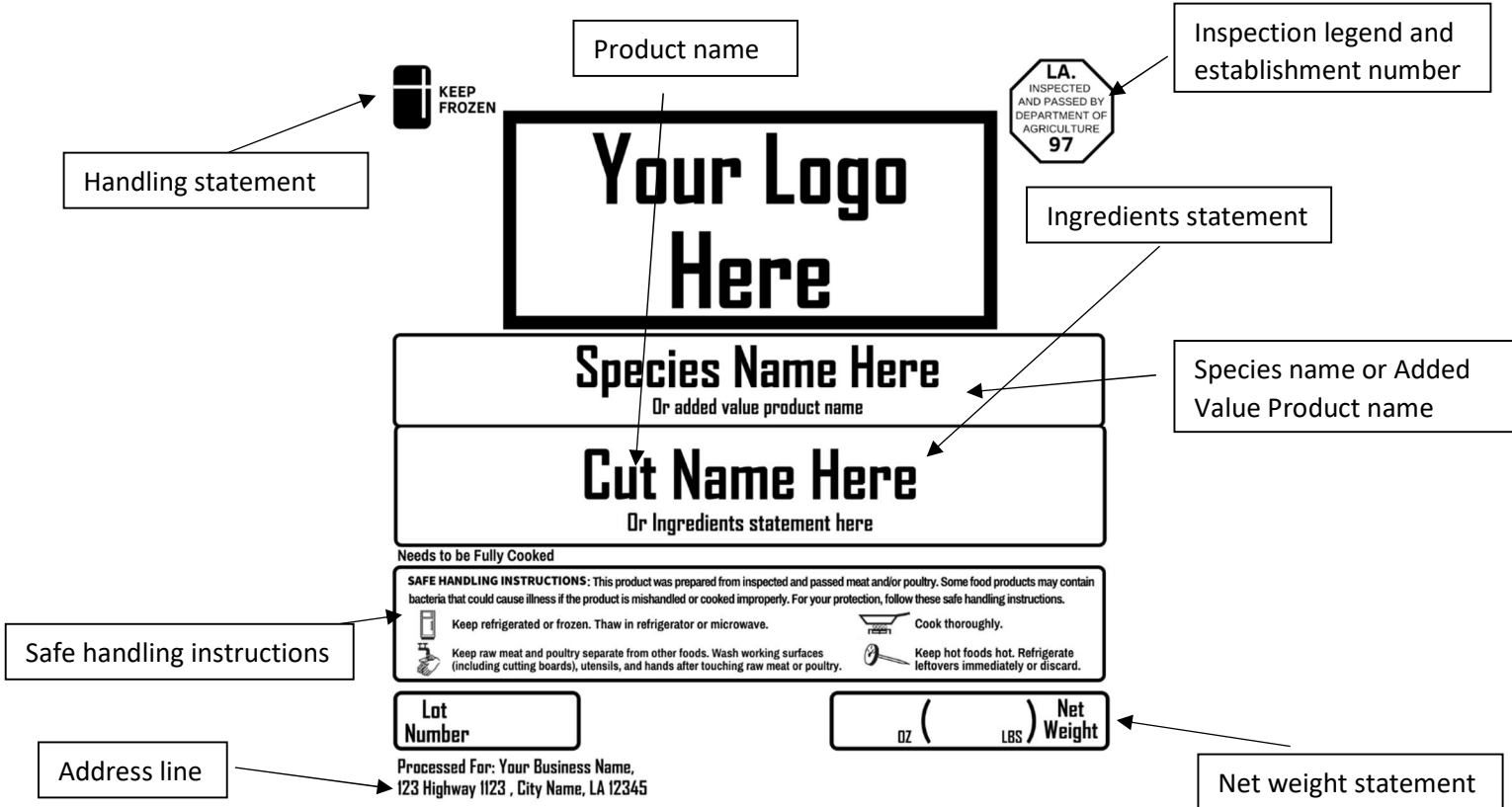

Depending on your processing numbers and what you would need specifically, we can create a custom layout for use with our Data at Print Time capability. Though our system is adaptable, it is not the best fit for every client! We understand and want you to be happy with your product and its packaging. If this is the case, we will manually input information onto your custom labels. This should only be necessary if your label is outside the capabilities of our printer function. Current max width 4 inches. (So your label could be 5x4 inches or 4x6 inches and we could still use it with our system)

We will not print any labels in house outside of 4x4 and 4x3 inch labels. Labels of various sizes may be printed by a printing company with the approval of a Parish Meat Processing Manager. Labels printed at a different facility will be the responsibility of the producer and will be warehoused at the processing facility. Label inventory will be the responsibility of the producer.
